- Description of the Work: This summary is not all-inclusive and delineates only those work items deemed as major to the contract. Ancillary work items not listed below, though necessary to attain the completed project, shall be included in the contract. General project scope is to replace existing Oil Water Separator serving Bldg 100. Major items of work shall include the following:
- Remove existing oil water separator (OWS) and dispose of in accordance with local, state and federal regulations.
  - Install new OWS above ground and connect to existing piping. OWS must meet all local, state and federal regulations as well as the following specifications: Flow Rate - 100 gal/min
  - Insulate and/or provide heating mechanism for above-ground equipment as necessary to avoid freeze/thaw conditions.
  - New OWS system shall not require Confined Space Entry into existing concrete vault in order to perform preventative maintenance or maintain the system.
  - New OWS system shall include new pump for transfer of oil to oil storage tank.
- Contractor shall provide all OWS product submittals for approval.
- Period of Performance: The period of performance for this project is 90 calendar days after Notice to Proceed is issued.
